

**MINUTES OF THE March 15, 2010 MEETING
Of
Our Lady of LaSalette Assembly #3115**

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm by SK Jack Pegoni.

The Faithful Navigator, Faithful Friar, and the Trustees were excused and all other Assembly Officers were in attendance.

The past meeting's minutes are posted on the Knights of Columbus web-site for review.

SK Pegoni will be attending the Biennial District Meeting in Greensboro, NC and will inquire as to the availability of any regalia being donated by deceased 4th Degree members. SK Pegoni is going to invited Color Corps members of the Southport and Wilmington Assemblies to participate in the dedication of the church.

Under new business, SK Pegoni discussed "Operation Rakkasans" which is a program to send personal item packages to members of the 101st Airborne Division serving in Iraq and Afghanistan. The packages are being sent to troops who do not have a family support system to send them packages. This operation is spearheaded by Gen. Joseph Kinzer, (Ret). The general has identified 3 Command Sergeant Majors to whom to send the packages and they will distribute them to the eligible troops. Knights may either bring the items to the next meeting and we will assembly the postal boxes and then the Knight will take a completed postal box and mail it. The cost to the Knight will be approximately \$12.00 for postage and what ever expenses incurred by purchasing the items. Or, a Knight can pick up a postal box and fill it on his own and mail the box on their own. SK Pegoni will be ordering the boxes from the Post Office and will make the list of items available to the members.

SK Norm Menlanson reported for the 3rd Degree Council that on Easter Sunday the Knights will be direction traffic in the parking lot at all the Easter Sunday masses. He is looking for volunteers. SK Menlanson mentioned that Ronnie Goins is looking for assistance in transporting her husband to Wilmington once a week for medical treatment.

Next meeting April 19, 2010 there will be Color Corps practice at 6:00 pm and a meeting at 7:00 pm. On the meeting agenda, there will be election of officers for the coming year.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 pm.
