The Faithful Friar explained the Parish Council's position on alcoholic beverage distribution or sale. It is acceptable for Beer and Wine, but no hard liquor. SK Robert Hack mentioned that the Assembly could purchase "Host Insurance" for liability protection during the event.

Report From the 3rd Degree

Grand Knight, SK Edwin Manz reported that he and the Deputy Grand Knight, SK John Yencik attended the North Carolina Knights of Columbus State Convention in Durham, NC May 13 – 15.

The 3rd Degree Ceremonial has been completely changed to reflect the Eucharist. SK Manz would like to have the Council sponsor a third degree at the church.

SK John Yencik mentioned that Vice Supreme Master Singer reported that the Military Order of the Purple Heart Wounded Warrior program for the State has almost depleted their funds assisting military personnel getting home for the holidays. SK Yencik suggested the Assembly continue supporting this program.
