

**MINUTES OF THE October 18, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 6:25 PM.

All officers were present or excused.

The minutes from the August meeting were posted on the Knights of Columbus Council 9039 website and were approved.

There were no communications and no new applications for membership.

Bank balance was \$1,173.31.

New Business:

Prior to the meeting, 4th Degree members, some wives, and the parish priests sampled three types of fish, French fries, and Cole Slaw. Since we do not have deep fryers, the fish entrees were baked. The haddock filets were voted the best tasting. This tasting was done in anticipation of the 4th degree preparing fish dinners during the Lenten season as our fund raising event. The estimated price for the dinners will be \$7.00. This fund raising project is still under consideration.

FN Pegoni distributed Color Corps Pins which are the only approved pin to be worn by the Color Corps while dressed in regalia. All other pins are not approved. One pin was issued to each member. In addition, all members of the Color Corps must be wearing the pin while in regalia. If one member does not have a pin, then all the other members must remove their pins during the event.

FN Pegoni mentioned establishing a Patriotic Award Program for patriotic activities performed by an individual member or group of members of the Assembly. This program is in the planning stages.

Sir Knight of the Month was awarded to SK Anthony "Jerry" Siegmund.

At the request of FN Pegoni a motion was made, seconded, and passed to repay Council 9039 the \$500.00, which was advanced to the Assembly as start up money.

The Assembly will make a donation of \$50.00 to the Wounded Warrior Program, which is the Charity selected by the Assembly. The Wounded Warrior Program provides money to wounded armed forces personnel in order to purchase transportation home for the

Thanksgiving or Christmas Holidays. SK George Mulchay made the motion and SK John Yencik seconded the motion and the motion passed.

The Shallotte Christmas parade will be held on December 4, 2010 at 9:00AM. The Assembly will provide an Honor Guard and the Color Corps will march in regalia proceeding the Council's Christmas Parade float.

There will be a mass for the deceased members of Council 9039 on November 2 at 9:00 AM and Veterans Day mass on November 11 at 9:00 AM. All members of the Council and Assembly should make an effort to attend.

Report from Council 9039:

SK Edwin Manz, Grand Knight, read a letter of appreciation received from the Retired New York City Firefighters. They thanked us for our participation in the 911 mass held this year at St. Brendan Church.
